Then it's out to the green pastures of the beautiful forest of Belize. Fly over the small but famous bathing spots such as Freetown Sibun, Butcher Burns, Cedar Bank and Gracy Rock Bank.



You will get a bird's eye's view of the very caves you will be experiencing while at Ian Anderson as we glide over Caves Branch where you will be able to see the beauty of the river as it flows through the cave system. This area encompasses a private 58,000 acres estate that is situated beneath a 100 ft rainforest canopy and is bordered by the turquoise waters of Caves Branch River. Your flight comes to an end as you arrive at your final destination – Ian Anderson's Caves Branch.
